ArtHamptons is known for presenting an art fair energized with art, events, celebrity sightings and the opportunity to meet up with plenty of Hamptons artists, collectors and art lovers. This year was no exception.

Held on the grounds of Nova's Ark Project, art greeted fair goers even before entering the sprawling white building constructed for the event.

Figurative work seemed to dominate this year's fair. Abstraction had a strong showing. Contemporary and Modern works were both presented. Sculpture, painting, photography and mixed media works were all represented.
