THE FIREPLACE PROJECT - "yes pleased" - A Solo Show by Terence Koh has an opening

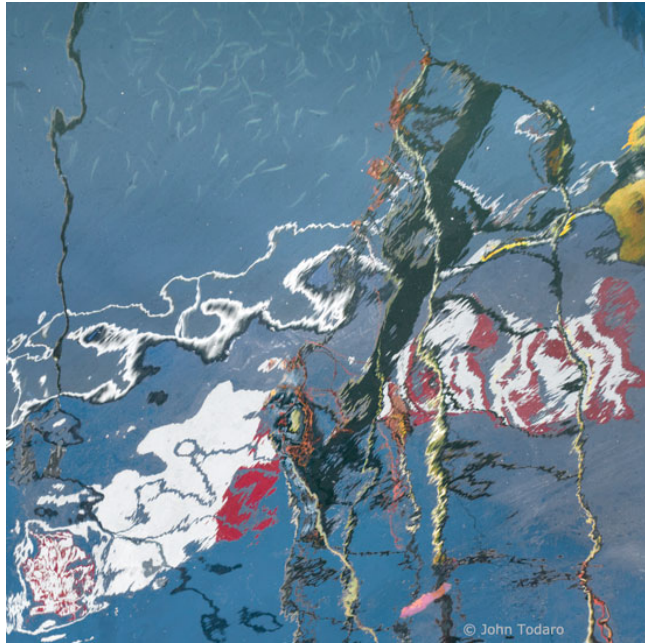

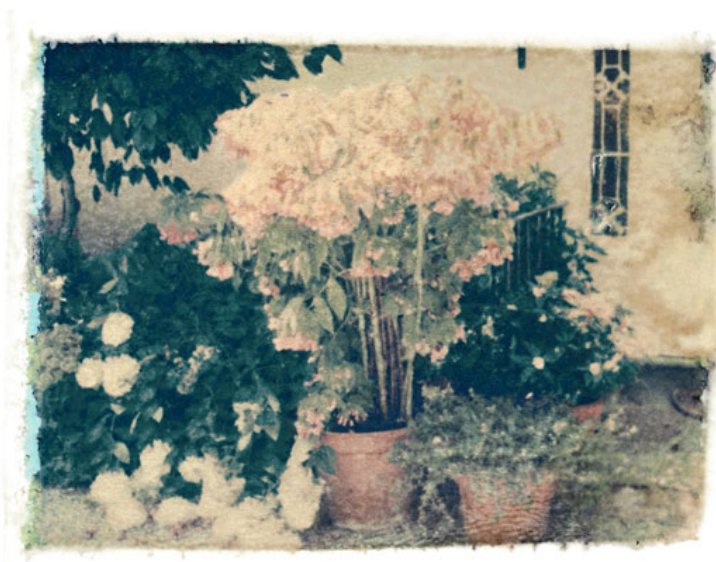
