White's paintings have been exhibited in solo and group shows on the East End. He describes his art as having a "whimsical surrealism."

White's early professional art career included a collaboration with singer-songwriter Harry Chapin (1942-1981) on the book "*Looking...Seeing.*" Chapin provided the poetry and White illustrated the book.
