“**SHADOWED DREAMS**” presents narrative artworks from artists who share similar sympathies. The art exhibited delves into private lives and passing moments of contemplation. Each artist, in his or her own way, captures people dabbled by secreted darkness. The art in “Shadowed Dreams” portray worlds filled with implied ambiguity, psychological wandering to murky places or fragmented dreams clinging to the reality from which they spring.

Art prices range from \$2,500 to \$45,000.
