“Plein Air Peconic VII” will be held from September 21 to October 22, 2012 at South Street Gallery in Greenport, NY.

“**Plein Air Peconic VII**” is an annual exhibition and sale of paintings and photographs of East End Landscapes featuring land conserved by the **Peconic Land Trust**. The exhibition is being held at The South Street Gallery, 18 South Street, Greenport, NY.

Coffee with the Artists: Sunday, October 14 - 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

The paintings and photographs in “**Plein Air Peconic VII**” feature landscapes of the beautiful East End including properties conserved by the **Peconic Land Trust**. Some of the preserved North Fork locations in this show include Dam Pond in Orient, Kujawski Barns in Jamesport and Reel Point in Shelter Island. The group has spent the last year working on the North Fork to capture vistas preserved by the Peconic Land Trust.
