HAMPTONS & NORTH FORK, NY-

There has been so many cancellations and reschedulings due to snow that it's tricky to know what's happening in the Hamptons art world. If you can leave your driveway, there is art and culture to be found. This info might come in handy as there's no leaving the East End until tonight!

The Long Island Expressway is closed from Exits 73 to 57 until around 5 p.m. for snow plowing, according to a Suffolk County Police Department <u>traffic advisory</u>. The Long Island Rail Road continues its suspension of train services east of Ronkonkoma, Babylon & Huntington, according to an MTA announcement.
