## **NEW YORK CITY, NY-**

Another art fair week is arriving in NYC adding to the quick pace of art viewing in the Big Apple. As always, Hamptons artists and organizations are in the thick of it. Listed below is a small slice of where to find Hamptons-related talent in NYC.

New shows are listed first according to opening dates. Exhibition closing immediately follow. Current shows continuing beyond the month are listed next. This column is updated as new information arrives.

### **OPENINGS:**

#### **MAY 2 (Friday)**

**“PORNALIKES”** by Piotr Uklański has an opening reception on May 3 from 6 to 8 p.m. The exhibition continues through June 8. Works on view are part of an ongoing series of photographs derived from the Polish artist’s image archive depicting porn actors who strongly resemble famous people from the here and now.
