ArtHamptons is poised to open tonight for its sixth edition. Taking place at Nova's Ark Project, the Black Card Holders First Hour takes place from 5:30 to 6:30 p.m. with the VIP Opening Preview Party taking place from 6:30 to 9:30 p.m. Tickets to the First Hour are \$250. The VIP Preview ticket costs \$125 and benefits Guild Hall.

ArtHamptons opens to the public tomorrow and continues through Sunday. Tickets are \$40 for a three-day pass and \$25 for a one-day pass. Select special events open to ticket holders include two panel discussions and a presentation on Larry Rivers:

**ArtSpeak - Friday from 2 to 3 p.m.** Curators discuss their roles as educators, collaborators and leaders. The panel is moderated by Helen Harrison, Director of the Pollock-Krasner House and Study Center. Panelists include curators: Sharon Matt Atkins of the [Brooklyn Museum](#), Christina Strassfield of [Guild Hall](#); Jenny Park Adam of ARTDEX and Ambre Kelly and Andrew Gori of [Schoolhouse Projects](#).

**Meet the Honorees - Friday from 4 to 5:30 p.m.** Dramatist Edward Albee and the [Larry Rivers Foundation](#) will be featured in a discussion by Benjamin Genocchio, Editor-in-chief of [Artinfo.com](#) and *Art+ Auction*.

**Life & Times of Larry Rivers - Sunday at 3 p.m.** Larry Rivers Foundation Executive Director David Joel discusses the life and times of the "Godfather of Pop Art" and explores River's Forty Feet of Fashion and *Legs* that's installed at the art fair entrance. The talk takes place at Tibor De Nagy Gallery booth, #400, who is presenting the lecture.
