This year’s guest curator is Jennifer Cross. Ms. Cross is currently chair of Visual Arts at Ross School in East Hampton and former director of East Hampton Center for Visual Arts.

Cross has chosen over 150 artists from the East End with distinguished careers. Many artists have participated and supported the show in past editions. Still other artists were selected for the first time to exhibit in this renowned show. Some of the selected artists are established and renowned and others are emerging. The Springs Invitational Art Exhibition has traditionally been a great way for collectors to purchase small works from important artists.

Along with the art show and sale, there will be an **Opening Wine Reception on Aug 2nd from 4-7 p.m.** The always well-attended **Fisherman’s Fair takes place on Aug 10th from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.** and offers local seafood, a craft area, and a children’s game area. It’s an event designed to please the entire family. Both events are free, open to the public, and are presented by the Springs Improvement Society.

This year the Arts Committee has added two very special events to complement the two-week exhibition. On **Aug 16th from 5-8 p.m.** there will be a **Black and White Gala “Ashawagh Honors”** with wine and hors d’oeuvres to recognize the artistic achievements, commitment and

devotion to the Arts by Eleanor “Chip” Leaver and Ralph Carpentier, both strong supporters of Ashawagh Hall and the Springs Improvement Society. At 6 p.m., the artist honorees will discuss their lives and careers over a glass of wine in the main room of the Hall. A short Q&A will follow.

Throughout the evening, Allen Merrill will play classical guitar. A donation of **\$15 per person or \$25 per couple** will be requested at the door. Proceeds will benefit the Springs Improvement Society and Ashawagh Hall.
