“Photo-Technic” Opens on Aug. 16 at the Alex Ferrone Photography Gallery.

A new art exhibit titled **“Photo-Technic”** opens on Friday, Aug. 16, and runs through Sept. 22 at the **Alex Ferrone Photography Gallery** on the North Fork. An Opening Artists’ Reception will be held on Friday, Aug. 16, from 6 to 8 p.m. with wines by Macari Vineyards and light fare.

“Photo-Technic” features works by two photographers using different photographic techniques. **Dave Burns** exhibits infrared images of Serengeti wildlife and landscapes taken while on safaris in Tanzania. **Gerry Giliberti** exhibits prints of still lifes and flora created with the alternative processes of Lumen and Solar Plate Printing.

Dave Burns is an award-winning photographer who specializes in wildlife, travel, and landscape photography. He has photographically chronicled his experiences traveling in more than 25 countries. Burns is based in Boston and has family ties to the East End of Long Island.

A member of East End Photographers Group and the North American Nature Photography Association, Dave’s photographs have been exhibited in many galleries and are included in numerous private collections.
