**WATERMILL CENTER -“Debra McCall: Lecture and Screening of Oskar Schlemmer’s 1920s**

**Bauhaus Dances**” will be held on Wednesday (Nov. 6) at 6:30 p.m. McCall will present her story of reconstructing the 1920s Bauhaus Dances of Oskar Schlemmer and explain the philosophy and work of Bauhaus artists, and screen a film of her reconstructions.

Bauhaus—a school of art, crafts, and technology founded by the architect Walter Gropius—embodied the zeitgeist of 1920s Weimar with such faculty as Paul Klee, Lyonel Feininger, and Wassily Kandinsky. Schlemmer’s early Bauhaus “lecture-dances” were to later inform the avant-garde work of Merce Cunningham, Robert Wilson, The Grand Union, Laurie Anderson, and David Byrne.
