



# Hamptons Art in NYC - November 2013

New York City is hopping and there are plenty of Hamptons-based artists to be found in exhibitions across the city. Of special note are solo shows by Dorothea Rockburne and Ilya and Emilia Kabakov. Rockburne is exhibited at MoMA and the Kabakov's have their first show at Pace.

Following is a select list of art exhibitions on view in New York City with a Hamptons connection. Exhibitions opening this month are listed first. Those closing within the month are listed next. Shows continuing beyond November are listed last. *Hamptons @NYC* is continuously updated as new information arrives.

## OPENING

### NOVEMBER 2 (SATURDAY)

**A new GROUP SHOW** has an Opening Reception on Nov. 2 from 3 to 5 p.m. at **OK Harris Gallery** in SoHo. The exhibition continues through Dec. 7. The exhibition features works by Peter Kirkiles, **Stephanie Brody-Lederman**, Gregory Perkel, Jeanette May, Jerry Monteith and Moses Hoskins. Brody-Lederman lives in the Hamptons and NYC. She won the 2013 Best in Show at Guild Hall's Member Exhibition.

**Charmion von Wiegand's** solo show presents 24 works which reveal a multifaceted artist whose vision remained strong while she continuously innovated, experimenting with medium, form, and style. **American Abstraction** features works by members of the **Transcendental Painting Group** (TPG) and the **American Abstract Artists** (AAA), an organization von Wiegand joined in the 1940s and served as president of from 1951 to 1953. There are 21 artists represented including John Ferren (1905 - 197) who worked in East Hampton and Agnes Pelton (1905 - 1970) who worked in Water Mill. Her studio was located in the Windmill currently on the Hamlet's Green.
