DECEMBER 19 (THURSDAY)

"SECOND ANNUAL YOUNG COLLECTORS EXHIBITION: SOLO SHOW BY LA2" has an Opening on Dec. 19 from 6 to 8 p.m. at Leila Heller Gallery in Chelsea. The exhibition continues through Jan. 8, 2014. A portion of the proceeds benefits Southampton Fresh Air Home, a camp for physically-challenged children that's based in the Hamptons. All artworks are priced no more than \$5,000.

At the opening, visitors are can bring their own objects to be tagged by LA2. The cost will depend on size of object and ranges from \$50 and up).

LA2 is best known for his collaboration with Keith Haring in the 1980s. LA2 / LAROC (American, b. 1966) are the tags taken by Angel Ortiz. LAROC's work was the subject of a solo show last summer at Lawrence Fine Art in East Hampton, NY.

The focus is on Rockburne's works on paper. Rockburne's work has been the subject of retrospectives at Guild Hall (1995) in East Hampton and at the Parrish Art Museum (2011) (in Southampton, at the time of the show).

"CHARMION VON WIEGAND: SECRET DOORS" and "AMERICAN ABSTRACTION, 1930-1945" continues through Jan. 4, 2014 at Michael Rosenfeld Gallery in Chelsea.

Charmion von Wiegand's solo show presents 24 works which reveal a multifaceted artist whose vision remained strong while she continuously innovated, experimenting with medium, form, and style. American Abstraction features works by members of the Transcendental Painting Group (TPG) and the American Abstract Artists (AAA), an organization von Wiegand joined in the 1940s and served as president of from 1951 to 1953. There are 21 artists represented including John Ferren (1905 – 197) who worked in East Hampton and Agnes Pelton (1905 – 1970) who worked in Water Mill. Her studio was located in the Windmill currently on the Hamlet's Green.
