It seems impossible to escape the snow lately but even sleet, slush and piles of the white stuff won't stop art on the East End. This week brings a strong showing of new art exhibitions, live music, author readings and other events. Following is this week's list of where to find art and culture this weekend and beyond.

EAST END - "WINTERFEST: LIVE ON THE VINE" continues its series of live music this weekend.
