Lots of eyes are on NYC for New York City Art Week. If you're staying on the East End, there's art and culture to be found. Live music is presented on both Forks and two new shows open in Amagansett. Following is this week's list of cultural options on the East End:

EAST END - "WINTERFEST: LIVE ON THE VINE" continues its series of live music this weekend. The music festival features over 100 concerts held at multiple venues across the North Fork and Riverhead. The festival is extended through March 16.

The majority of concerts are held at wineries on the North Fork. Admission is \$20 per concert or by a "Festival Hopper" passes.
