EAST END, NY-

This weekend feels like a harbinger of things to come in the Hamptons summer art scene. Both museums hold special exhibition openings on Saturday, the Pollock-Krasner House & Study Center opens its doors and ushers in its first exhibition of the season and art openings flourish at galleries across the East End.

If that wasn't enough, the Clay Art Festival is being held this weekend and Bay Street Theatre holds its 2nd Annual Steinbeck festival featuring three days of screening. On Sunday, the Hamptons Take 2 Documentary Film Festival holds a special screening timed for the day after the the Kentucky Derby (held on May 3) . Will there be mint juleps at their Sunday benefit luncheon held at the American Hotel? It's a question the interested may want answered.
