Museum Look - May on Long Island

The Long Island museum scene bursts at the seams with new shows and activities. East End museums open for the season and several new exhibitions across Long Island highlight photography. Following is the full list of exhibitions presented at Long Island museums in May.

HAMPTONS

DAN FLAVIN ART INSTITUTE - BRIDGEHAMPTON

ON PERMANENT VIEW is an installation by Dan Flavin (1933-1996) of nine works in fluorescent light made between 1963 and 1981. The exhibition follows Flavin's art practice from when he began to work solely with standard fluorescent fixtures and tubes to just before the presentation of his new art form was realized.
