The Parrish Art Museum and the Suffolk County Historical Museum may be drawing a lot of attention this weekend. The Parrish has a full slate of weekend events designed to welcome two major exhibitions to the museum. The Suffolk County Historical Museum (along with much of Riverhead) is celebrating Edgar Allan Poe with a new exhibition and a sprawling festival in Riverhead. Elsewhere on the East End are exhibition receptions, screenings, talks and other events.
