Live music and lectures continue to dominate the cultural scene in the Hamptons and the East End of Long Island. 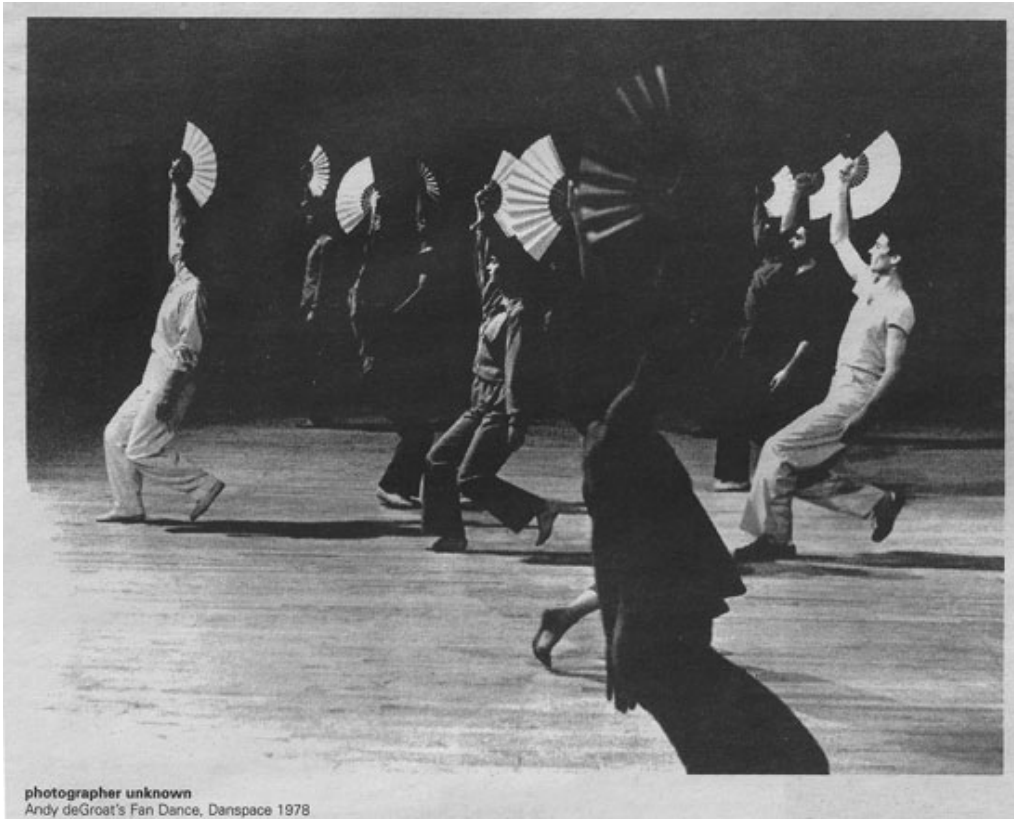
