Hamptons Art Hub recently issued an open call for fine art and fine art photography inspired by the cold muse of winter. The results are in! A committee selected 15 photographs and 15 artworks from online submissions. These works are now presented in two separate slideshows.

All totaled, Hamptons Art Hub received 235 submissions with 99 fine artworks to consider and 136 photographs. Artists from around the world emailed work with the majority living in the United States. Many are based in the Hamptons / East End - Long Island - New York City areas. Most of the photography submitted was made in February 2015.

Thank you to everyone who submitted! The art presented made for some tough choices. All work was considered without artist name by a committee and viewed virtually. Only one artwork per artist was eligible.
