



Artist William King Honored at Guild Hall on Saturday

Guild Hall is holding a celebration and memorial for artist William King (1925 - 2015) on Saturday at 11 a.m. Immediately following, a reception will be held at the East Hampton museum. William King died at his East Hampton home on March 4, 2015. The sculptor was 90 years old.

His work is also held in Guild Hall's permanent collection. His art will be included in the museum's next show, "Selfies and Portraits of the East End" exhibited from June 20 to July 26, 2015.
