SEPTEMBER 3 (THURSDAY)

"ERIC MEOLA STORM CHASER: NEW PHOTOGRAPHS" opens on September 3 at Bernaducci Meisel Gallery in Hell's Kitchen. The exhibition remains on view through September 26. An Opening Reception will be held on September 3 at 5 p.m. **Eric Meola** is based in Sagaponack, NY.
