But just because there are more things to do doesn't mean there's more time. Following is our short list of five things to do this weekend with an art or culture twist.

1. FILM

Hamptons International Film Festival opened on Thursday and continues through Monday with film screenings, panels, events and more set from Southampton to Montauk. 2. MUSIC

"Songs of Solomon" a Gospel Concert hosted by the Bridgehampton Presbyterian Church takes place on Saturday, October 10, 2015. 3. GALLERY EXHIBITION

Landscape painting and photography are the subject of the weekend-only exhibition "[Plein Air Peconic X](#)". An Opening Reception takes place on Saturday from 5 to 8 p.m. and Meet the Artists Coffee takes place on Sunday from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. One reason to see the show is proceeds from art sales benefits the Peconic Land Trust, who works to preserve natural spaces on the East End. Another reason is the art-painting landscapes and working en plein air are traditions going strong in The Hamptons. This group of artists and photographers contribute to its continuation on the East End.

Plein Air Peconic X is on view on October 10 from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m., on October 11 and 12 from 10

4. MUSEUM EXHIBITION

Roy Lichtenstein is well-known pop artist. In a solo show of his work, “[Roy Lichtenstein: Between Sea and Sky](#)”, his playful nature and experimentation with materials is brought to the forefront through a collaboration between Guild Hall and the Roy Lichtenstein Foundation. So is Lichtenstein’s interest in landscape and seascape as inspiration and genre. The show presents over 30 artworks making use of paint, Plexiglas, Rowlux, enamel, film, steel and more materials. 5. CLASSICAL MUSIC

Award-winning pianist [Soyeon Kate Lee](#) presents a recital on Friday, October 9, at 6 p.m. as part of The Parrish Art Museum’s Salon Series. The Korean-American pianist has won awards in competitions held throughout the world. A Naxos recording artist, she has given recitals at Lincoln Center’s Alice Tully Hall, Carnegie Hall’s Hall, the Kennedy Center in Washington, DC, the Ravinia Festival, Madrid’s National Auditorium, San Francisco’s Herbst Theatre and more.
