



Art Basel Miami Beach Features 26 Artists in Public Sector

Art Basel Miami Beach announced 26 international artists will transform Collins Park with 27 site-specific installations and performances for its Public Sector for the 2015 art fair. The public exhibition is curated by Nicholas Baume, Director and Chief Curator of Public Art Fund, who returns for his third year in curating Art Basel Miami Beach's Public Sector.

With a theme of 'Metaforms', the exhibition presents large-scale and site-specific installations plus performances by leading and emerging artists from over 11 countries. The exhibition will be produced in collaboration with the Bass Museum of Art for the fifth consecutive year.

The Public sector opens on Wednesday, December 2, 2015 with a special performance program featuring [Xavier Cha](#) (b.1980, United States), [Ryan Gander](#) (b. 1975, United Kingdom), [William Pope.L](#) (b. 1955, United States) and [Yan Xing](#) (b. 1986, China). The full exhibition remains on view through Sunday, December 6, 2015, coinciding with ABMB.

After the Miami art fair closes, a selection of installations will remain on view in Collins Park through February 1, 2016 as part of "[tc: temporary contemporary](#)", a city-wide temporary public art program presented by the [Bass Museum of Art](#) in partnership with the City of Miami Beach.

[Collins Park](#) is located between 21st and 22nd Street, adjacent to the Bass Museum of Art and in close proximity to the Miami Beach Convention Center where Art Basel Miami Beach holds its art fair.
