

Roll Call: Guild Hall's Artist Members Exhibition Top Honor Winners

The days are dwindling to apply to Guild Hall's 78th Artists Members Exhibition. The non-jured and judged exhibition is a popular one for many reasons. For those living in The Hamptons and the East End, the exhibition helps launch the pre-season for art in The Hamptons. It's also a community-driven exhibition where many of the artists living and working on the East End turn out to support the show or to discover the artists who took wins from the judged show. Attending the Opening Reception is a great way to catch up with Hamptons and East End artists to discover what they've been up to over the long winter.

The Artists Members Exhibition provides a draw for artists for another reason: the Top Honors winner receives a solo show at <u>Guild Hall Museum</u> and joins a long line of noteworthy artists to become part of Hamptons art history. This year's Awards Judge is <u>JiaJia Fei</u>, the Director of Digital for <u>The Jewish Museum</u>. The exhibition itself will be held April 23 to June 4, 2016. An Opening Reception takes place on April 23, 2016 from 4 to 6 p.m. with the exhibition and the winners both revealed.

"This is a wonderful opportunity for artists to exhibit their work in this long-standing exhibition which is viewed as kicking off the art season in the Hamptons," said Guild Hall Director/Chief Curator Christina Mossaides Strassfield. "Every artist in our community is invited to join Guild Hall and participate with the potential of being awarded a solo exhibition."

This was the second Top Honors win for Brody-Lederman and a first for the Artists Members Exhibition. Her work also won Top Honors in 2003, selected by Carolyn Lanchner, a former curator at MoMA (Museum of Modern Art).
