1. Ecological Artist's Modified Houseboat Comes to the East End

Mary Mattingly's "WetLand" will be open to the public Fridays through Mondays from June 9 – 23, 2016 and can be visited from noon to 5 p.m. on the Long Wharf.

"WetLand" is a modified houseboat made by the ecological artist <u>Mary Mattingly</u> to demonstrate easy sustainability projects such as solar power, rain water collection and purification, vegetable gardening, upcycling, and more. The vessel is being brought to the East End in conjunction with the exhibition, "<u>Radical Seafaring</u>," at the <u>Parrish Art Museum</u>.
