A solo show of Larry River's work opens this weekend at Vered Gallery in East Hampton Village. The show features two suites of work: *Me and My Shadow* and *Oedipus Rex*. An Opening Reception for the public takes place on Saturday from 8 to 11 p.m. A private reception is being held Friday night. ## Final Weekend: Peter Beard

This is the final weekend to visit Peter Beard's solo show at Guild Hall museum in East Hampton. "Peter Beard: Last Word From Paradise" takes over the entire museum and features works focused on either Africa or the East End of Long Island. The exhibition is Beard's first U.S. museum solo exhibition in 15 years. On view are over 50 multi-layered collages, drawings, photographs, and diaries from the 1960s to the present. The works in the Africa focus includes iconic works that reveal the changes in the landscape. In the East End focus, expect to find Montauk portraits of Peter Beard's home, family and friends including [Mick Jagger](#), [Andy Warhol](#), [Jacqueline Onassis](#), and [Lee Radziwill](#).
