Springs Invitational

The 49th Annual Springs Improvement Society's Invitational Exhibit opens Friday night at Ashawagh Hall with an Opening Reception taking place from 5 to 8 p.m. This year's curator is artist Nicolas Tarr. For her Parrish Road Show, [Bastienne Schmidt](#) combed the Whaling Museum's collection for functional objects with lattices or grids – such as nets, strings, and hardtack – and reinterpreted them through translucent paper works that incorporate threads, fabric and natural elements.
