The [Islip Art Museum](#) presents its second edition of "Slide Slam 2" at RIPE Art Gallery in Huntington on Wednesday, October 19, from 6 to 8 p.m. Sponsored in conjunction with the Long Island Museum and RIPE Art Gallery, the artist-centric program is designed to give artists selected from an Open Call the chance for exposure in communities across Long Island and to discuss their art at an event filled with artists and art professionals. To achieve this goal, selected artists for exhibition opportunities will be matched with venues outside of their community.
