Street Painting Festival in Riverhead

East End Arts will be holding its daylong celebration of the arts, the 21st annual Community Mosaic Street Painting Festival, on Sunday, May 28, 2017, from 12 to 5 p.m. Rain date is Monday, May 29, from 2 to 5 p.m.

With its centerpiece modeled on the efforts of 16th century street painting "screevers" in Britain and "i Madonnari" in Italy, the long running festival is an annual event that brings together people and families of all ages in a celebration of the arts and community. Using pavement squares sponsored by businesses and families as their canvas, artists will create chalk art compositions on Riverhead's Main Street. The festival will also feature live music, dance, gourmet food trucks, arts and crafts fair, and an array of activities for the young ones.
