Live in HD! National Theatre’s “Amadeus”

Peconic Landing presents “Captured Live in HD! National Theatre presents: Amadeus” on **Sunday, June 11, 2017 from 3 to 6 p.m.**

Peconic Landing will screen live in HD “Amadeus,” broadcast by the National Theatre with live

orchestral accompaniment by Southbank Sinfonia. The play tells the story of young Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart's relationship with court composer Antonio Salieri upon Mozart's arrival in Vienna, the music capital of the world. Seized by jealousy for Mozart's talent, Salieri begins a war with Mozart and with the music world in general.

"Amadeus" won multiple Olivier and Tony Awards after premiering at the National Theatre in 1979. It was later adapted into an Academy Award-winning film.
