"Boeing Boeing" centers on 1960s bachelor Bernard. Living in a flat in Paris and engaged to three gorgeous stewardesses seems idyllic until Bernard's friend Robert comes to stay and a new speedier Boeing jet launches and throws a wrench into his carefully calculated planning. With all three stewardesses in town simultaneously, Robert forgets which lies go where and chaos ensues. "Boeing Boeing" won two Tony Awards, including Best Revival of a Play and for [Mark Rylance](#) as Leading Actor in a Play. At Center Stage, "Boeing Boeing" features Dane DuPuis, Shannon DuPuis, Samantha Honig, John Leonard, Catherine Maloney and Josephine Wallace.
