#### Films on Artist Howard Kanovitz at The Parrish

The Parrish Art Museum presents "Film Screening and Q&A with Filmmakers Lana Jokel, Rainer Gross, and Carolyn Oldenbusch," on **Friday, November 24, 2017 at 6 p.m.** This evening is in collaboration with <u>HT2FF</u> (Hamptons Take 2 Film Festival) and in conjunction with the current exhibition, "From Lens to Eye to Hand: Photorealism 1969 to Today."

"Camera and Mirror—Painting Through the Lens: Howard Kanovitz", 2007, NR, 28 minutes, is a look into <u>Howard Kanovitz</u> (1929-2009) during the period when his work evolved from abstract expressionism to photorealism. "Hamptons Drive-In,", 1972, NR, 30 minutes, featuring archival footage of the Hamptons, documents the making of Kanovitz's iconic painting by the same name.

The screening will be followed by a conversation with <u>Lana Jokel</u>—a long-time friend of Kanovitz, , her collaborator <u>Rainer Gross</u> who worked with Kanovitz from 1971-74, and Kanovitz's widow, Carolyn Oldenbusch, moderated by Terrie Sultan. Lana Jokel is known for her documentaries on important artists including Robert Motherwell, Lee Krasner, Claes Oldenburg, Andy Warhol, and Larry Rivers.

## Final Weekend for "Death of a Salesman" at Bay Street
