## Live Radio Play at Southampton Cultural Center

“A Christmas Carol, A Live Radio Play” has its final run of performances **Thursday, November 30, 2017 through Sunday, December 3, 2017** at the Levitas Center for the Arts at Southampton Cultural Center. Performances will be held on Thursday and Friday at 7 p.m. Saturday at 2, 5 and 7 p.m. and on Sunday at 2 and 5 p.m.

Based on the classic story, *A Christmas Carol*, this production is Joe Landry’s take on the epiphany of Ebenezer Scrooge. Produced and written as a live 1940s radio broadcast, the adaptation visually and aurally recreates the era and the hopeful message that define the original work.
