Guild Hall presents "William Shakespeare's Romeo and Juliet," from **March 14 through 25, 2018**. Performances will be held on **Wednesdays and Thursdays at 10 a.m. and on Friday through Sunday at 7 p.m.**

This edgy and contemporary interpretation of "Romeo & Juliet," features a cast of twenty-one actors ranging from high school students to 20-something recent conservatory graduates as well as a few veteran Actor's Equity professionals thrown into the mix. All will come together on a stage backlit by projections and drenched in the post-punk score, to re-tell a story that we think we know so well. Directed by Josh Gladstone.

Spike Lee’s “Do the Right Thing” Screens

The Sag Harbor Cinema Arts Center presents “THE AMERICAN VALUES series: Do the Right Thing,” on **Sunday, March 18, 2018 at 2 p.m.** The screening will be held at the Pierson High School auditorium in Sag Harbor, NY. Ashley Clark, the senior programmer of cinema at [BAM](#) in Brooklyn, is the special guest.

A handful of characters, a single Brooklyn block, the hottest day of the year — in 1989, Spike Lee extracted from this microcosm what remains one of his most provocative and most inventive works to date: a hip hop opera on race relations, urban survival, violence and Sal’s Famous Pizzeria. Highly controversial prior to its release, “[Do the Right Thing](#),” with its blend of painterly hyperrealism and Brechtian cool, was embraced by both audience and critics alike.
