Over 65 million people around the world have been forced from their homes to escape famine, climate change and war in the greatest human displacement since World War II. "[Human Flow](#)," a film journey led by the internationally renowned artist [Ai Weiwei](#), gives a powerful visual expression to this massive human migration.
