Film on van Gogh's Life and Death

The Hamptons International Film Festival presents "NOW SHOWING: Loving Vincent," on **Friday**, **April 27**, **2018 at 6 p.m.** The film will be screened at the <u>Southampton Arts Center</u>.

"Loving Vincent" (Poland/UK, 2017, 94 minutes), is the 2017 biographical and animated painted drama about the life and death of <u>Vincent van Gogh</u>. Each of the film's 65,000 frames is an oil painting on canvas created by a team of 115 painters who use the same technique as the famed artist. Written and directed by Dorota Kobiela and Hugh Welchman.

Nazi-Looted Art Lecture

The Amagansett Free Library presents "From Murder To Museums: Current Controversies Over Nazi-Looted Art," on **Sunday, April 29, 2018, from 2 to 3 p.m.** The talk will be held in the Community Room.

Join Raymond Dowd, an attorney specializing in copyright litigation and Nazi art looting, for an overview of art theft during the Second World War and a look at how the sale of stolen works bankrolled large parts of the Nazi war machine. By exploring past and ongoing cases, Mr. Dowd will discuss laws that were passed to address the looting, and will examine the extent to which those laws have been successful in securing the return of stolen art to its rightful owners.
