

Largest Keith Haring Mural in Europe Unveiled in Amsterdam

A monumental mural by Keith Haring (1959-1990) has been discovered, restored and newly unveiled in Amsterdam, making it the largest mural by Haring in Europe, according to Juxtapox Magazine. The mural is a whimsical "sea monster" ridden by a figure in recognizable iconography for Haring, painted in white. The mural was created in 1986 on the former depot of the Stedelijk Museum but lay concealed beneath aluminum plates for 30 years, explained Widewalls magazine. The mural was made in the same year as his solo show at Stedelijk Museum and measures 12 x 15 meters.

The resurfaced mural was unveiled on Monday, June 18, 2018 during a press conference at the historic Markt Kwartier (Food Market) with fanfare, according to Juxtapox. The mural's preservation and restoring to the public eye was spearheaded by graffiti artist Aileen Middel aka Mick La Rock, who was in attendance, as well as Stedelijk Museum Director Jan Willem Sieburgh; Vroom & Varossieau gallerist Oliver Varossieau and Director of the Keith Haring Foundation in New York. The quest to save and revitalized the mural was four years in the making, according to <u>Widewalls Magazine</u>. Mick la Rock sought to preserve the mural after the building was sold and demolition was part of the possible plan, according to Widewalls.

Haring's mural can only be seen from afar as the property is not accessible to the public, reported Widewalls. In other recent Haring art news in Amsterdam, a velum canopy Haring made for Stedelijk Museum was restored and exhibited from October 11, 2017 to June 3, 2018 in the museum. Haring made the canopy for the museum's grand hallway on the occasion of his solo show there in 1986, according to the museum. Click here to see the work.
