Inspired by the Museum's exhibition "Keith Sonnier: Until Today," Ron Wendt's decor evoked the artist's luminous neon sculptures. Guests entered a space that reflected both the industrial and

ephemeral—with red, blue, yellow, orange, and green fluorescent lighting artfully situated on black table cloths, with black and red chairs peppered throughout the terrace. The minimalist design was balanced with meandering Ruscus vines (a romantic nod to Sonnier's Louisiana roots) draped from ceiling to table and subtly wrapped in Edison bulbs.

Music was supplied by DJ Alice Longyu Gao and catering by Olivier Cheng Catering + Events.
