Historic Art Forensics & Craft Brews at the Parrish

The Parrish Art Museum presents “Illumination: Revealing the Secret Chemistry of Oil Paintings” on **Friday, September 21, 2018 at 7 p.m.**

Scientists from the Metropolitan Museum of Art, Brookhaven National Lab and Stony Brook University have joined with the Parrish Art Museum’s Terry Sultan to reveal scientific mysteries that lie within historic artworks, specifically a 15th century oil painting by [Jan Van Eyck](#). The program will take place in a pub-like atmosphere in the museum’s Lichtenstein Theater. Special menu items including international and domestic brews will be available for purchase.

Don Giovanni Opera at Bay Street Theater
