Conceptual Chalkboard Art Experience

North Fork chalk artist Kara Hoblin leads participants in the conceptual art project “BIG ERASE” on **Thursday, December 20, 2018 from 6 to 8 p.m.** at the Southampton Arts Center.

Led by chalk artist [Kara Hoblin](#), participants will make a drawing in chalk and then erase as a way of letting go of unwanted attachments. Hoblin leads by example and plans to erase a selection of her large chalk drawings during “The Big Erase.” Live music by Julia King and refreshments complete the experience.
