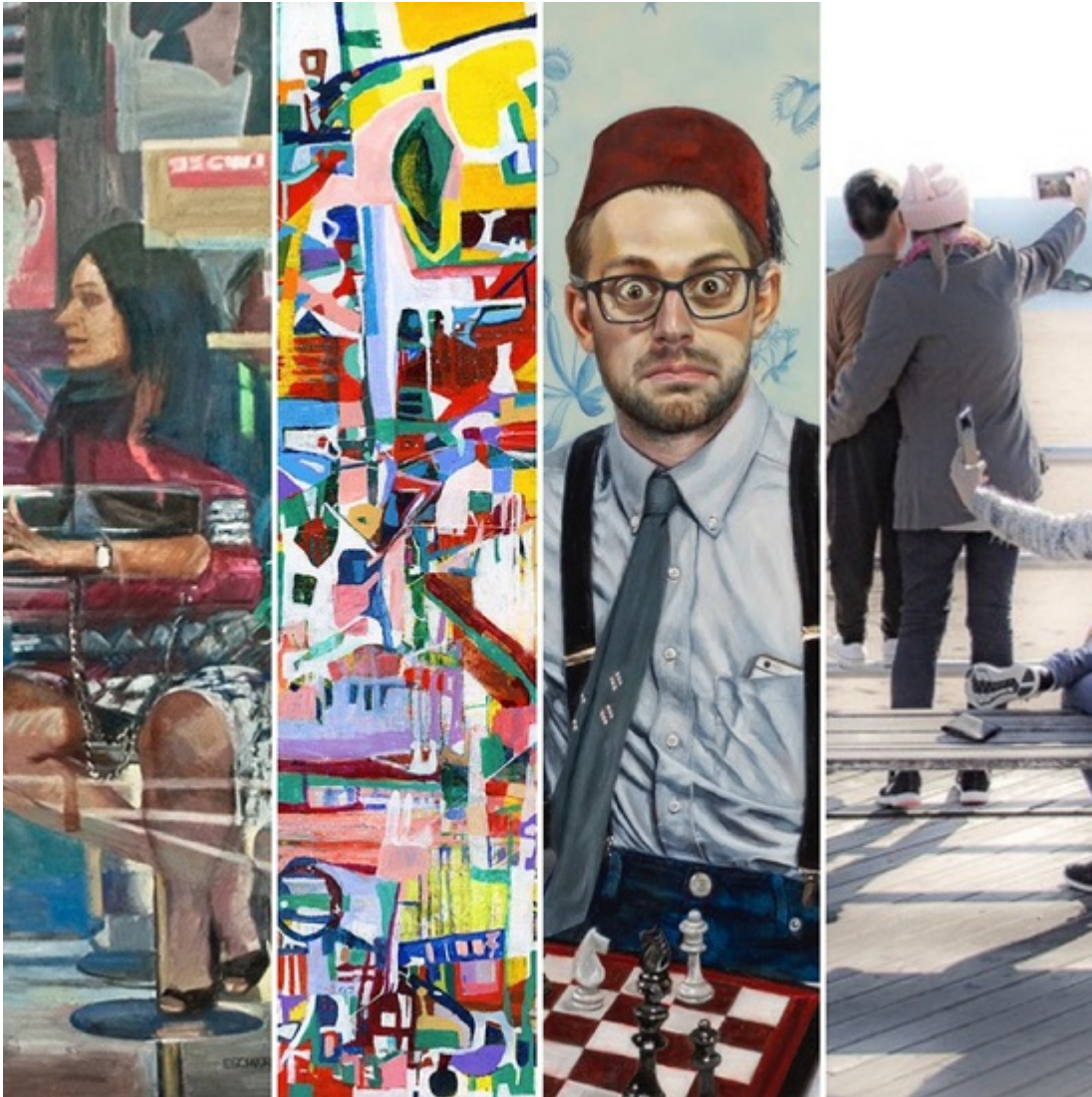


“BE REAL” Online Exhibition Presented by Hamptons Art Hub
