Theater continues to be strong this weekend with two worthwhile (and very different) productions taking the stage. Also on our list of the top things to do are a sound mediation gathering and an exhibition tour by artist winners. All events take place through Sunday, March 17, 2019.

1. Dramatic Theater - Final Performances for “Falls for Jodie” at Guild Hall

“Falls for Jodie” by Eric Micha Holmes will be performed **March 6 to 17, 2019; Wednesdays through Saturdays at 8 p.m. and on Sundays at 2 p.m.**

“Falls for Jodie” is an imaginative peering into John Hinckley’s life during a transformative time before he attempted to assassinate then US President Ronald Reagan. The fictitious look, based on actual events, has the audience getting to know Hinckley as he attempts to court actress Jodie Foster as a Yale student, his fateful decision to purchase a gun, and the role the friendship with a hotel concierge may have played in Hinckley’s life.

The play is recommended for ages 13 and up as the performance contains strong language. Seats are limited as the audience watches the play from the stage set around the action.
