**HALSEY MCKAY GALLERY** - "**Glen Baldrige - No Way**" and "**Richard Tinkler - Widening Circles**" have an Opening Reception on Saturday, June 8, 2019 from 6 to 8 p.m. Presented as concurrent solo shows, "No Way" features Baldrige's paintings that draw upon paper marbling techniques to make abstract paintings of camouflaged texts. Tinkler's "Widening Circles" presents paintings in an ongoing body of work that makes use of repetition as catalyst. It is Tinkler's first show with gallery.
