2. "The Lehman Trilogy" Comes to Guild Hall

A live screening of the play "The Lehman Trilogy," performed in London, will be shown at Guild Hall as part of its National Theater Live program **on Friday, October 4, 2019, at 7 p.m.**

"The Lehman Trilogy" takes place in 1844 and tells the story of three brothers from Bavaria who, searching for success in America, establish The Lehman Brothers, an investment firm that then collapses into bankruptcy and triggers the largest financial crisis in history 163 years later. The five-time Olivier Award nominated play is written by Stefano Massini, adapted by Ben Power, directed by Sam Mendes, and stars Simon Russell Beale, Adam Godley and Ben Miles. The play will be broadcast live from London's West End.
